What to expect when you enter a horse with Hutter Sport Horse Auctions

Stabling and training

- Stabling is available at \$35/ day, \$250/ per week or \$1000/ month at one of our lower mainland locations.
- Training is available at \$40/ per training ride. This also includes rides for showing/ trials.
- Full training before the sale is an additional \$150/ week.

Grooming

- Braiding is \$30 for jumper/dressage braids. \$45 for hunter braids
- Mane pull \$20
- Bathing is \$25
- Full body clip \$100
- Leg/face clip \$40
- Presentation day includes free running and jumping videos, along with conformation pictures. \$100
- Riding presentation day for broke horses includes flat video and jumping video. \$100
- All grooming charges are non-refundable
- Total grooming plus presentation day package \$350
- Farrier can be arranged upon request \$150 fronts \$220 all round.

Entry fees & commissions

- Entry is \$150 and is due before horse is listed publically. Entry fee is non-refundable.

- Commission of 7% is charged when the horse sells including up to 30 days post auction.
- Commission of 10% is charged when the horse sells 15 days prior to the sale.
- Withdrawal fee of \$100 is charge if a horse is vet scratched or withdrawn prior to the sale.

Vetting

- All horses require health papers and coggins approx. \$180
- Basic PPE for foals, broodmares, and horses valued under 15k is available for \$200. Broodmares add \$70 for ultrasound and \$60 if sedation is needed.
- PPE for elite horses (valued above 15k) varies from \$600-1000 includes health check of eyes, ears, lungs, legs, body palpitations flexions, lunging and 12 mandatory x-rays.
