

# HUTTER SPORT HORSE AUCTIONS XRAYS

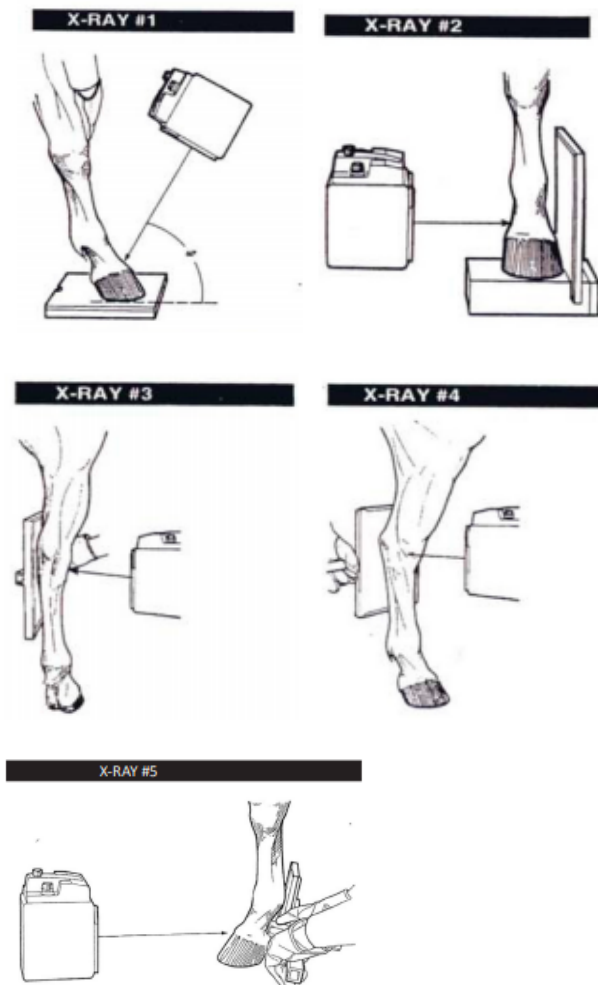
Radiographs are required for any horse entered in an Elite Auction, or any horse with a reserve over 15k.

Radiographs must be done within 60 days of the sale and must be submitted latest 5 days before the sale starts.

Radiographs must be done in horse's registered name and must be submitted online or via email in JPEG for to [info@huttersporthorseauctions.com](mailto:info@huttersporthorseauctions.com)

If your horse has any blemishes or bumps that may be of a concern it is highly recommended to have those x-rayed as well to verify suitability.

## REQUIRED VIEWS

#1 60° Dorsoproximal - Palmarodistal view (front hooves)

#2 Lateromedial view (hooves, pastern & fetlock)

#3 20° Lateromedial view (left and right hock)

#4 30° Dorsolateral-plantaromedial oblique view (the left and right hock)

#5 Horizontal Dorsoproximal - Palmarodistal view (fetlock, pastern and coffin of both front legs)

- Additional views may include neck, back, stifles, knees and/or any blemishes.
- Buyer may do additional x-rays pending sale of horse. This must be done within 2-3 days after end of sale.
